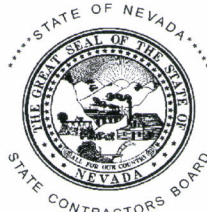

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STATE CONTRACTORS BOARD

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING
November 14, 2018**

CALL TO ORDER:

Noah Allison, Esq. called the meeting of the State Contractors Board to order at 8:30 a.m., Wednesday, November 14, 2018, State Contractors Board, Henderson and Reno, Nevada. Exhibit A is the Meeting Agenda and Exhibit B is the Sign in Log.

Licensee was present but not represented by counsel at the hearing.

ALJ Allison found Respondent guilty of one (1) violation of NRS 624.3014(1)(a) acting in the capacity of a contactor under any license issued except in the name of the licensee as set forth upon the license. The First, Second, Third, Fourth, Sixth and Seventh Causes of Action were dismissed. Respondent was assessed a fine of \$50.00 for the Fifth Cause of Action and investigative costs of \$2,513.00. Fines and investigative costs are due within sixty (60) days of November 14, 2018 or license number 71368, Creative Curbing, LLC shall be suspended.

ALJ Allison found Respondent guilty of one (1) violation of NRS 624.302(7) failure to comply with an order of the Board. Respondent was assessed a fine of \$500.00 for the First and investigative costs of \$1,857.00. Respondent’s license limit was lowered to \$10,000.00. Fines and investigative costs are to be paid within ninety (90) days of the November 14, 2018 hearing or license number 10062, Vernon Herbert Dimick, Owner, dba Dimick Drilling shall be revoked.

9. DISCIPLINARY HEARING: DEFAULT ORDERS

a. UNIVERSAL ELECTRIC CONTRACTORS, LLC, dba UNIVERSAL ELECTRIC & SOLAR,
License No. 76589

Licensee was not present nor represented by counsel at the hearing.



ALJ Allison found Respondent Universal Electric Contractors, LLC, dba Universal Electric & Solar, license number 76589 in default and adopted the Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law as set forth in the Administrative complaint. Respondent was found guilty of one (1) violation of NRS 624.301(4) failure to prosecute a construction project with reasonable diligence; one (1) violation of NRS 624.301(1) abandonment of a construction project undertaken by a licensee as a contractor; and one (1) violation of NRS 624.301(5) failure to comply with the terms of a construction contract. Respondent was assessed a fine of \$1,000.00 for each of the First, Second and Third Causes of Action for total fines of \$3,000.00 and investigative costs of \$1,013.00. License number 76589, Universal Electric Contractors, LLC, dba Universal Electric & Solar was revoked. Respondent is required to make full restitution to all damaged parties and reimburse the Board for any monies paid out of the Residential Recovery Fund plus pay the fines and investigative costs prior to consideration of future licensure.


There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned by ALJ Allison at 11:42 a.m.
