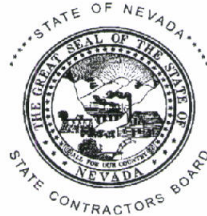

STATE CONTRACTORS BOARD

MINUTES OF THE MEETING
July 16, 2019

CALL TO ORDER:

Noah Allison, Esq. called the meeting of the State Contractors Board to order at 8:30 a.m., Tuesday, July 16, 2019, State Contractors Board, Henderson and Reno, Nevada. Exhibit A is the Meeting Agenda and Exhibit B is the Sign in Log.

1. DISCIPLINARY HEARING: (Continued from June 19, 2019)

KEVIN LEE ROBINSON, OWNER, dba KEVCO CONSTRUCTON & DESIGN, License No. 30505

KEVIN LEE ROBINSON, OWNER, dba HUNTER ELECTRIC, License No. 38140

Licensee was present but not represented by counsel at the hearing.

ALJ Allison found Respondents guilty of two (2) violations of NRS 624.3015(2) bidding for a sum for one construction project in excess of limit placed on license by Board; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(1) failure to keep records for a period of not less than 3 years after the completion of project; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3015(1) acting in the capacity of a contractor beyond the scope of the license; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(3) failure to establish financial responsibility; and one (1) violation of NRS 624.3018(2) certain persons are prohibited from serving as officer, director, associate or partner of licensee. Respondents were assessed a fine of \$5,000.00 for the First Alleged Violation; a fine of \$1,000.00 for the Second Alleged Violation; a fine of \$5,000.00 for the Third Alleged Violation; a fine of \$3,500.00 for the Fourth Alleged Violation; a fine of \$500.00 for the Fifth Alleged Violation for total fines of \$15,000.00 and investigative costs of \$4,107.00. Fines and investigative costs are to be paid within ninety (90) days of issuance of the Decision and Order or license number 30505, Kevin Lee Robinson, Owner, dba KEVCO Construction & Design and license number 38140, Kevin Lee Robinson, Owner, dba Hunter Electric will be suspended. License number 30505, Kevin Lee Robinson, Owner, dba KEVCO Construction & Design and license number 38140, Kevin Lee Robinson, Owner, dba Hunter Electric were revoked. The revocations were stayed and the licenses were placed on Probation for Two Years. Kevin Lee Robinson was ordered to retake and pass the CMS exam within sixty (60) days of issuance of the Decision and Order. A license bond for license number 30505, Kevin Lee Robinson, Owner, dba KEVCO Construction and Design was ordered in the amount of \$20,000.00. The license bond on license number 38140, Kevin Lee Robinson, Owner, dba Hunter Electric was raised to \$10,000.00. Both bonds are to be in place within sixty (60) days of issuance of the Decision and Order. All contracts entered into for projects of construction must be writing. Respondents shall submit to four business reviews within the two year probation period beginning with August 30, 2019. At the conclusion of the probation period, if the Respondents' licenses have not otherwise been revoked, suspended, or otherwise disciplined, the stay shall be lifted and the probation terminated and the licenses placed on active status.



ADJOURNMENT


There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned by ALJ Addison at 4:38 p.m.
